

Declaration

of the information requirement under Article 33 of Regulation (EC) Nr. 1907/2006 for articles

One of the aims of REACH is to regulate the use of substances of very high concern (SVHC). A first step in the complex process of regulating such substances is the inclusion of them to the SVHC list (so-called candidate list).

Based on Article 33 of the REACH Regulation (Regulation (EC) Nr. 1907/2006) any supplier of an article containing SVHC substances of more than 0.1 mass percent must inform the recipient of the article.

Additionally, we as a company are obliged to report these products to the SCIP database (SCIP = Substances of Concern In Products) of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) regarding to Article 9 of the European Waste Framework Directive (Directive 2008/98/EC).

To comply with these obligations as a producer of articles, we are sending this letter and an accompanying annex to you.

In the annex **only** those products are listed which contain SVHC substances with a concentration of more than 0.1 mass percent. You can also find the notification numbers of the SCIP database for the affected products.

Please note that the candidate list is revised by ECHA regularly (usually twice a year) and that the attached annex only refers to the candidate list as of **14 June 2023**. In case of relevant changes, we will automatically provide you with new data on the concerned products.
